Statement of Evidence

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 7, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers layed out the original township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann did the original township subdivision.

In October 1991 DNR Bureau of Engineering dug and no evidence was found. Bruce W. Shepperd, LS 17003, set a DNR survey marker on the center line of the east-west road and in line with the fence to the south.

On May 27, 2016 county records show an aluminum capped iron pin 0.40' below the surface of the road.

On June 7, 2024, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{3}{4}$ " rebar with an aluminum DNR cap on top.
