

Statement of Evidence

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 8, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858, W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861, Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft dated June 6, 1895 notes a 4"x4"x14" stone at the corner.

County records dated May 1, 1988 notes a field stone found at the corner and a steel pin placed above the stone.

County records dated March 2000 note a $\frac{3}{8}$ " rebar found at the corner.

County records dated May 25, 2012 note a $\frac{3}{8}$ " steel pin found at the corner.

On July 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{3}{8}$ " iron in the center line of the road, probed along side and did not hit the stone.

On July 17, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe and found nothing, returned on July 30, 2025 and placed a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 at the position of the found $\frac{3}{8}$ " iron.
