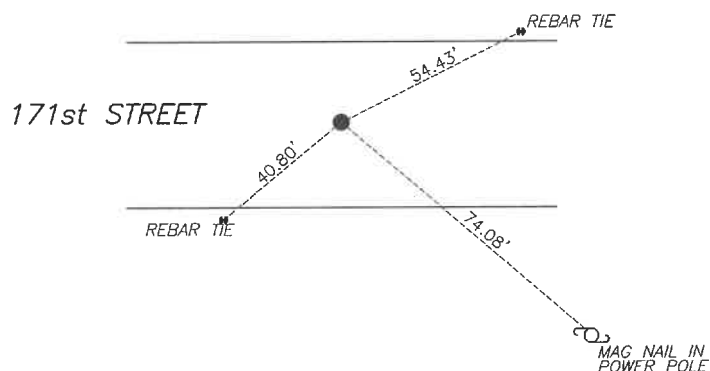

Statement of Evidence

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 8, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 L. Brochmann subdivided the township.

In November 2008 Perry Zieske dug and found a 12x15" stone at the corner and placed a 1" iron pipe with cap #23008.

In September 2020 Westwood Professional Services searched and found an iron with a cap #23008.

June 7, 2024, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying, found capped iron (No. 23008). Previous ties are good.
