
At the corner location shown on the sketch:

On 11/7/2025 placed a concrete monument with "+" on top and a wood stake on the north side of the monument.

Statement of Evidence

Northeast Corner Section 1, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the original township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

A survey from October 12, 1899 represents it as a township corner.

County survey records from 1940 show a concrete monument placed at the corner.

In June of 2014 Dennis Esplan set a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43803 at the corner.

In September of 2020, Jason Latzke with Westwood Professional Services found the monument set by Esplan.

On June 7, 2024, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43803.

On November 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe and found a concrete monument with a "+" on top and a rotted wood stake on the north side of the concrete monument. Placed a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 on the north side of the concrete monument for locating purposes.

Pin set by Esplan is South 27°51'14" West of the concrete monument a distance of 0.76'.
