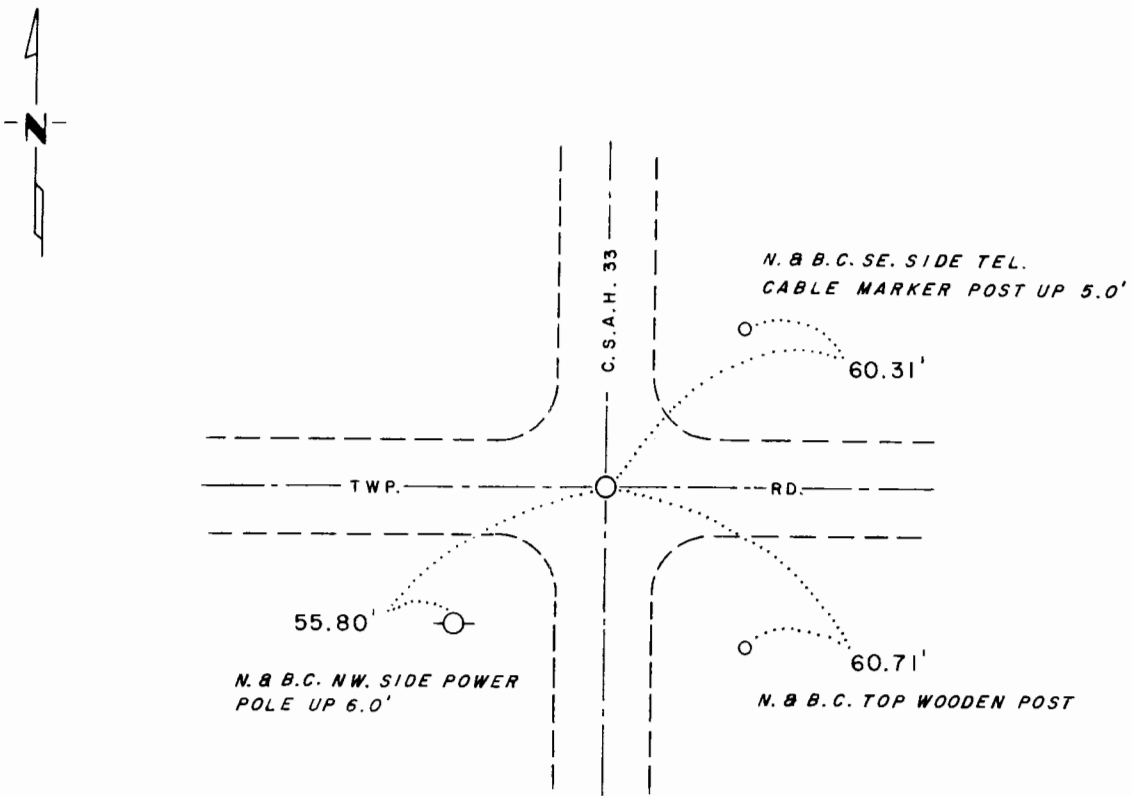
Northeast Corner of Section 10, Township 105, Range 41, 5th P.M.

Statement of Evidence:

Northeast Corner Sec. 10 T 105 - R 41

Murray County

This corner was originally established by the U.S. General Land Office survey in 1861. The government notes show corner marked with a wood post set in mound of earth with pits and trench dug around the mound.

In May, 1977 the DNR Bureau of Engineering contracted the Murray County Offices of the Recorder, Auditor and Engineer for corner information.

Information found in the section book at the Engineer's office was a survey by J. W. Woolstencroft of Section 10 in R 01. He shows a stone with "+" at this corner and ties to fence corners NE, SE, SW and NW. Also on this page is written that the DNR set iron pipe at this corner and gives ties.

In 1957, the DNR assumed this corner at the road intersection.

In 1970, we found this assumed corner and set an iron pipe.

On May 24, 1977, we found this iron pipe with a R.R. spike inside at the road intersection. Because of the record of a stone being set at this corner, we hired Sidney Pope to dig for this stone with his backhoe. We found a 9" x 10" stone with "+" down 4.5' with a 2" x 2" x 18" wooden hub over. The stone was 8" below an old road bed. We set a 8" x 9" x 16" stone over the other stone and the hub was laid beside it. A 3/4" x 24" iron rod was set over the stone at the surface. The iron pipe and the R.R. spike were removed.
