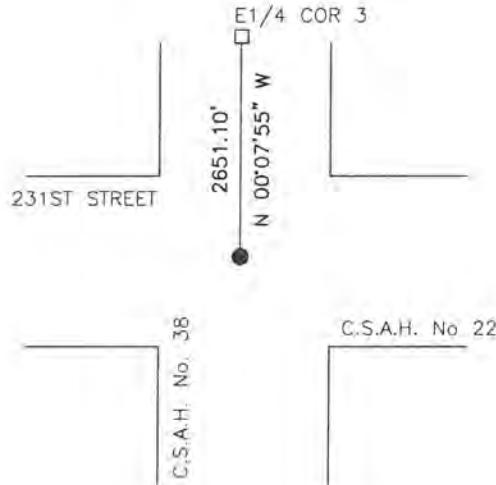

Statement of Evidence

In 1861, Lewis Brockman did the original subdivision of the township.

On May 12, 1899, J.W. Woolstencroft recorded a stone and iron at the corner.

In 1936, No name, recorded a concrete stone at the corner.

On June 18, 1971, Murray County Highway Department found a iron pipe at the corner. They set a steel pin over the pipe.

On June 2, 2015, Murray County Highway Department set a mag nail at the corner.

On July 29, 2015, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a mag nail at the corner, it matched 1971 county ties.
