

Statement of Evidence

Northeast corner Section 13, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

County records dated November 15, 2002 show Zieske Land Surveying found an iron monument at the corner.

On April 3, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying searched the intersection and found a large bridge spike, decided to dig.

On August 26, 2025 dug with a backhoe and found a large pointed field stone with remnants of a wood stake around the stone. Accepted the stone as the corner.

On October 13, 2025 returned and set a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 over top of the stone.
