Statement of Evidence

NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 14, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858, W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861, Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

May 1914, J.W. Woolsencroft survey shows a stake at corner.

County records from August 30, 1926 note a stone for the corner located 4' north of grade.

County records from July 17, 1973 notes an old hub an nail found below the road surface 4' north of road centerline. He then placed a new hub with an iron pin set above the hub.

On June 28, 2024 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{5}{8}$ " bent iron at the location of the corner.

On July 23, 2024 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug a large 6.5'x10'x5' deep hole at the location of the bent iron and found no trace of the corner.

Returned on January 29, 2025 and placed a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 in the location of the iron.
