Statement of Evidence

NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 15, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft dated July 5, 1911 notes a concrete stone at the corner.

A survey dated August 30, 1926 notes a stone at the corner.

In 1967 an iron pin was placed at the corner 3" below grade.

On July 23, 2024 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{3}{4}$ iron, removed the iron and dug a large hole with a backhoe and found nothing.

Returned on January 29, 2025 and placed a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 at the location of the $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron.
