

Statement of Evidence

NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 15, T107N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft dated April 10, 1907 notes that he established the corner but did not note what he set.

County records dated November 13, 1997 notes Perry Zieske, LS #23008, found an 8" stone and placed a pipe with his seal over top of the stone.

A survey in 2010 by Perry Zieske, LS 23008, shows a found monument at the corner.

A survey in 2010 by Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying shows a found iron with seal #23008.

In September of 2020, Westwood Professional Services located a 1" iron pipe with an unreadable cap.

On May 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a 1" pipe with an unreadable cap at the corner, the position fits well with previous surveys. Accepted pipe as corner.
