

Coordinate System NAD83 (1996)



Statement of Evidence

NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 16, T107N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

A corner certificate dated December 3, 2013 by Perry Zieske, LS #23008, notes on November 3 of that year he found a 6"x10" stone at the corner and placed a  $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #23008 over top of the stone.

In September of 2020 Westood Professional Services found a  $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #23008 at the corner.

On May 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a  $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron, probed along side and hit the stone monument beneath. Accepted the iron as the location of the corner.
