



Statement of Evidence

Northeast Corner Section 17, T105N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In September of 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the South township boundary.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the North, East, and West township boundary lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

Survey record of section 17 dated October 2, 1898 notes a stone in place at the corner.

Survey record of section 16 dated September 6, 1926 notes a stone in grade at the corner.

A survey in section 16 by Perry Zieske, L.S. #23008, dated November 18, 2013 notes a p.k. nail at the corner.

On March 6, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a p.k. nail at the corner, the corner fell in the center of the intersection.

Returned on October 8, 2025 and set a 3" survey spike with seal #43844 at the location of the p.k. nail after the road over lay.
