

Statement of Evidence

NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 19, T107N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft dated May 22, 1901 notes an 8"x10"x18" stone at the corner.

County records show an iron pin placed at the corner in 1963.

County Records dated April 18, 1978 shows they dug a 6'x6'x6' hole with a backhoe and found nothing.

County records dated November 23, 1987 note a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron rod at the corner.

County records dated March 30, 2012 show Zieske Land Surveying located an iron monument at the corner.

On August 27, 2020 Westwood Professional Services located a No. 6 rebar with no cap at the corner.

On May 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron at the corner, probed along side the iron and hit the stone beneath. Accepted the iron as the corner.
