Statement of Evidence

In 1861, J. W. Myers did the survey of the south township line.

On April 18, 1979, the Murray County Highway Department found a concrete monument at the corner. They placed an steel pin over it.

On October 12, 1993, the Murray County Highway Department placed a PK nail at the road surface.

On May 14, 2007, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a PK nail at the road surface. We dug by hand and found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron. We set a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 at the road surface.
