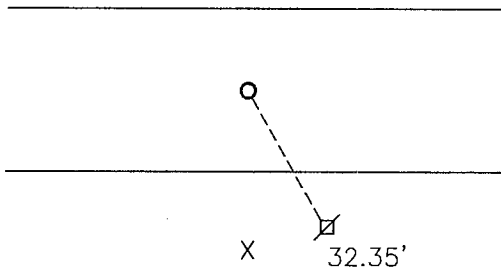

Statement of Evidence

In 1866, J. W. Bishop did the subdivision of the township.

In 1957, the Murray County Highway Department found a stone at the corner.

On June 15, 2011, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a bachoe. We found a large field stone with a ring of smaller field stones around it. We set a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 on the north side of the stone and a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 above the stone. The corner is in the center line of the road and in line with the fence to the north.
