

Statement of Evidence

Northeast Corner Section 24, T106N, R40W of the 5th P.M.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the original township lines.

In August of 1861 D.W. Wellmans and S.S. Smoot subdivided the township.

County records dated May 19, 1898 notes a Government mound & stake and stone.

County records dated 1940 notes a concrete monument at the corner.

County records dated 1965 notes an iron pin placed over top of the concrete monument.

County records dated May 5, 2008 notes Perry Zieske, L.S. 23008, notes he found a pipe with seal #23008.

County records dated May 23, 2010 notes a 1" steel pipe at the corner.

Count records dated May 23, 2012 notes a 1" steel pipe at the corner.

On May 22, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{3}{4}$ " pipe at the corner, removed and dug with a backhoe for the concrete monument. Dug a 4'x6'x6' deep hole and found no evidence of the monument. Accepted the position of the $\frac{3}{4}$ " pipe and set a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844.
