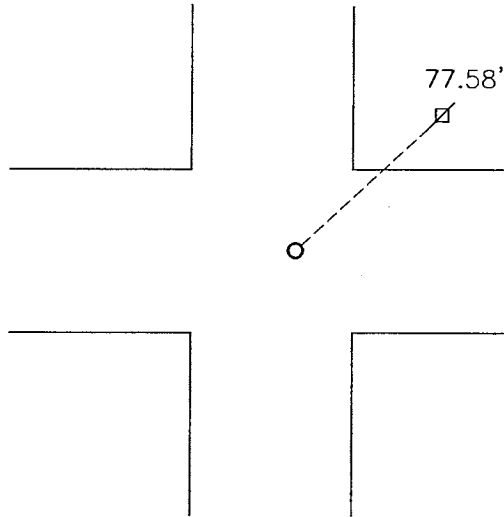

Statement of Evidence

(No Date) J. W. Myers did the original survey of the township lines.

(No Date) Minnesota Department of Transportation highway plans noted that the corner is to be 2.5' east of the centerline.

On May 18, 2011, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron at the corner. The corner is 2'± east of the centerline.
