

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER


Northeast Corner of Section 25, Township 106, Range 40, 5TH P.M.

At the corner location shown on the sketch:

- On 5/22/2025 found a Government stake and stone 1.5' below grade, set a 5/8" iron
with seal #43844 in between the stone and the stake.
 left monument as found, lowered monument, removed monument (explain)
- On 6/10/2025 placed a 5/8" iron with seal #43844 over top of the stake and stone.

Statement of Evidence

Northeast Corner Section 25, T106N, R40W of the 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east line of the township

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 D.W. Wellmans and S.S. Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey of section 25 by J.W. Woolstencroft dated November 21, 1902 notes a government stake and stone at the corner.

On May 22, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a 2"x24" pipe, removed and continued digging. Found the government stake and stone as called for by the 1902 survey 1.5'± below the road surface. We set a 5/8" iron with seal #43844 in between the stake and the stone for locating purposes.

Returned on June 10, 2025 and set a 5/8" iron with seal #43844 over top of the stake and stone.
