

Statement of Evidence

NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 32, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft dated July 19, 1896 notes a government mound at the corner.

County records from 1934 shows a concrete stone found at the corner.

1975 - Murray County Highway Department found concrete monument and set ties.

On June 5, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found p.k. nail at surface. It matched 3 of the 4 ties from 1975. Accepted position of p.k. nail.

On October 8, 2025 and set a 3" survey spike with seal #43844 at the location of the found p.k. nail after overlay.
