
Northeast Corner of Section 35, Township 107, Range 39, 5TH P.M.

Statement of Evidence

Northeast Corner Section 35, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In October of 1857 J.W. Meyers surveyed the east boundary of the township.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the remaining township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

A survey of section 25 by J.W. Woolstencroft dated October 11, 1924 notes a white stone in grade at the corner.

Undated survey records note a concrete monument at the corner.

MN DOT plans from October 1951 notes a stone monument at the corner.

On July 17, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe and found a cone shaped concrete monument laying on its side, removed and continued digging and found a white flat top stone. Accepted the white stone as the monument and reset the concrete monument over top of the stone.

We returned on July 30, 2025 and set a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 over top of the concrete monument and stone.
