



SKETCH OF REFERENCE TIES





Statement of Evidence

NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 4, T105N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September of 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the south township boundary.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the North, East, and West township boundary lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township:

An undated survey by J.W. Woolstencroft notes he found the government mound and stake at the corner.

On May 5, 1976 a field stone was located at the corner and placed a 1"x12" iron above the stone.

County records dated May 5, 2004 notes Zieske Land Surveying found an iron monument at the corner.

May 14, 2025, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found 1" solid iron. Probed and hit stone. Accepted 1" solid iron.
