

Statement of Evidence

Northeast Corner Section 5, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

An undated survey record of section 5 shows a hub in place at the corner.

Survey record dated April 13, 1978 shows a concrete monument in place at the corner.

An undated survey record of Section 32-108-39 notes a concrete monument found at the corner.

County record dated March 21, 2000 notes a $\frac{3}{8}$ " iron in place at the corner.

County record dated July 18, 2017 notes a No. 4 rebar at the corner.

On August 27, 2020 Westwood Professional Services located a No. 4 rebar without a cap flush with asphalt.

On May 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron with out a cap flush with the asphalt. Accepted the iron as the corner.
