

Statement of Evidence

Northeast Quarter Corner Section 6, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers layed out the original township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann did the original township subdivision.

An undated survey shows a concrete stone at the corner.

County records dated 1934 show a concrete stone located at the corner.

County records show in 2008 Perry Zieske, LS 23008, found a concrete monument with a chiseled "x".

On June 4, 2024 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a concrete monument with an iron with survey cap, LS 45874, on the north side of the monument.
