### Statement of Evidence

NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 7, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers layed out the original township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann did the original township subdivision.

In October 1991 DNR Bureau of Engineering dug and found a 12" by 19" by 19" granite stone down 2.5 feet with lath next to it. They then placed a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron with an aluminum cap stamped "DNR SURVEY MARKER" over top of the stone.

County records show on October 28, 2008, an iron monument was located at the corner by Zieske Land Surveying.

County records show on May 26, 2016, an iron pin with a DNR survey cap was located at the corner.

On June 7, 2024, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron with an aluminum cap stamped "DNR SURVEY MARKER" at the corners location.
