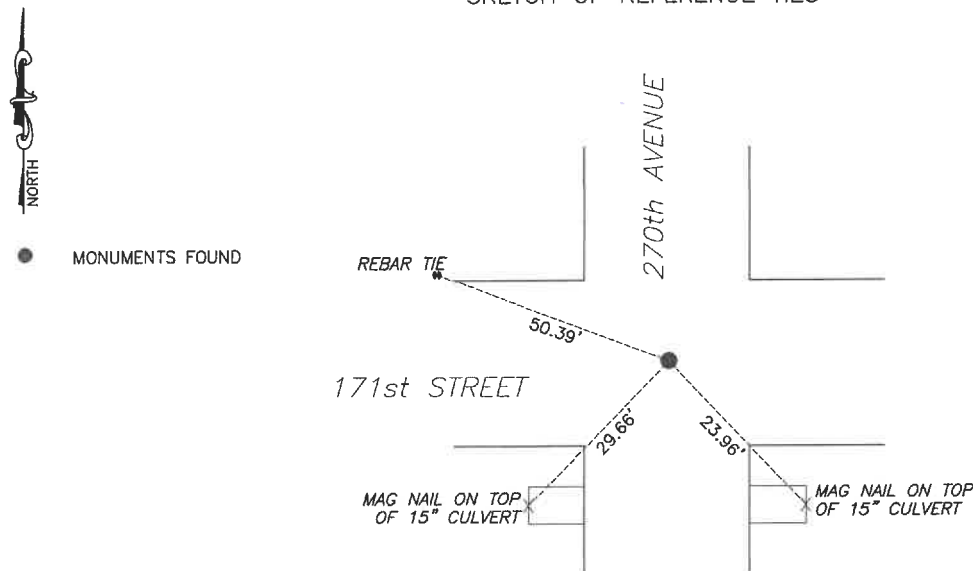

Statement of Evidence

NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 9, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

June 22, 1913, J.W. Woolsencroft survey of Sec. 3-107-39, shows a stone at corner.

In October 1980, Gary Martin, LS#12967, found a blue granite stone at the corner and placed a $\frac{1}{2}$ " Iron and cap above the stone.

In May 2016 Highway Department data shows that an iron with cap #12967 was found.

In September 2020 Westwood Professional Services searched and found an iron with cap LS #12967 at the corner.

On June 7, 2024 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron with survey cap #12967.
