In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

June 22, 1913, J.W. Woolsencroft survey of Sec. 3-107-39, shows a stone at corner.

In October 1980, Gary Martin,LS#12967, found a blue granite stone at the corner and placed a $\frac{1}{2}$ " Iron and cap above the stone.

In May 2016 Highway Department data shows that an iron with cap #12967 was found.

In September 2020 Westwood Professional Services searched and found an iron with cap LS #12967 at the corner.

On June 7, 2024 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron with survey cap #12967.
